14th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Green)

Spiritual reflection on the scripture and homily of the weekend liturgy

- What is God saying to me through these Scripture readings?
- What word or phrase touched me or was memorable from the Gospel or Homily?

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Green)

Spiritual reflection on the scripture and homily (see above questions)

July 12, 09 Amos 7:12-15; Psalm 85:9-14; Ephesians 1:3-14; Mark 6:7-13

- When Jesus sent the disciples out, he was preparing them for the future when he would be gone. How are you growing in your own faith and preparing for a life as a Christian disciple?
- Why do you think Jesus sent them out two by two, rather than alone?

16th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Green)

Spiritual reflection on the scripture and homily (see above questions)

July 19, 09 Jeremiah 23:1-6; Psalm 23: 1-6; Ephesians 2:13-18; Mark 6:30-34

- Jesus was moved with pity for the people who were gathered. Who are the people you are moved with pity for? What can you do to help them?
- How do you keep Sunday as a day of rest?

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Green)

Spiritual reflection on the scripture and homily (see above questions)

July 26, 09 2 Kings 4:42-44; Psalm 145:10-11,15-18; Ephesians 4:1-6; John 6:1-15

- Generosity is key to today's Gospel. What do you have that you should be sharing with others?
- Think of your possessions, your talents, and your time. How can you use these for the good of others?
